Leh Ladakh tour packages include treacherous passes, bike tours, offroading, and all the exciting stuff which you want to take up in your dream trip to Leh Ladakh. For adventure seekers, Leh, Ladakh is heaven as it has everything on offer which gives you adrenaline rush such as hiking, camping, trekking and much more. The lengthiest tour package to Leh Ladakh is a round trip to Leh from Delhi, approaching Leh Ladakh from Srinagar and leaving this heaven from Manali. We start this tour from the beautiful valley of Srinagar, often referred to as the heaven on Earth. From Srinagar, we leave for Leh Ladakh and end this dream Leh Ladakh dream tour from Manali. An alternative route of approaching Leh via Manali and exiting via Srinagar is also popular. The major attractions in this Leh Ladakh tour are the war memorial dedicated of our warriors who laid their lives in the Kargil War, Leh, the land of lamas and monasteries, Khardung La and Tanglang La; the highest and next highest motorable roads in the world, the cold desert of Nubra and the double humped camels, world famous Pangong Lake, confluence of Indus and Zanskar river, physics defying Magnetic Hill, picturesque view of lesser known Sarchu and crossing the Rohtang Pass/Atal Tunnel.


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


BRIEF ITINERARY



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DAY 01 Your dream tour to Leh Ladakh kicks off by waking up in the morning wee hours and gearing up to meet at India Gate. After a quick briefing session, the whole group starts off from here for the life time dream trip to Leh, Ladakh, Pathankot being the first stop over of this trip. We kick off from New Delhi and reach Ambala, cross Ludhiana and reach Pathankot by evening. Stay overnite at Pathankot and gear up for the next day's trip to Srinagar

DAY 02

The second day, we get ready to hit the roads to reach the mesmerizing valley of Srinagar, through the longest tunnel of India, Chenani - Nashri Tunnel, leading to the gateway to Kashmir. Reach Srinagar, check into your hotel and indulge in local sightseeing for the rest of the day. Visit the Dal Lake for a shikara ride, the Mughal Gardens, the Shankracharya Temple to name a few.





DAY 03 Today, we begin our journey from the green land of Srinagar towards the dry and arid land of Leh Ladakh, halting at Sonmarg and night stay at Kargil. We ride to cross the Zoji La Pass and reach the majestic Tiger hill. Ride towards Drass - the second coldest inhabited place on earth. Visit the Drass war museum to pay respects and pray for the peace of the brave souls of the valiant jawans who fought and sacrificed their lives during the Kargil war of 1999. Overnite stay at Kargil.



The road from Kargil to Leh resembles a runway and constitutes the first part of the day's journey. As you traverse from Kargil with an Islamic dominant population, to Leh, a Buddhist dominant area, feel the symbolic transformation. We cross the Fotu La, the highest pass on the Leh - Srinagar road. We visit the Lamayuru monastary, highest monastery in Ladakh, Sangam, magnetic hill, pray at Gurudwara Pathar Sahib and visit Hall of Fame. On reaching Leh Ladakh, we break for one day for acclimatization.

DAY 05 On the fifth day of this tour, you can enjoy Leh as a place. After a hearty breakfast, set out for local sightseeing, exploring Leh and the neighboring attractions, visiting Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace and local market. This day is at your leisure. Give proper rest to yourself and your beasts for the later part of the trip. In the later part of the day, check and gear up the bikes as necessary and get ready for the adventure that is to follow the next day.

DAY 06 Gear up and speed off on the smooth tarmac to meet the board showing "The Highest Motorable Road in the world" at Khardung La Pass. After taking a break for photo session on this high pass to the Nubra Valley, we head towards Khardung village where you can have a quick break for tea and snacks. We proceed towards Nubra Valley as we cross the Khalsar and Diskit sectors.





DAY 07 Ride towards the Turtuk Village, the last Indian village before the border line with Pakistan. Being part of the Baltistan region of the Himalayas, it is one of the last village on the indian side of LOC, being part of 5 small villages to fall in the Indian Territory. This small village, native to the Balti people, is very popular for the fruits grown in this region, especially Apricots. Come back to stay the night at Nubra.

DAY 08 From Nubra Valley, we head towards yet another fascinating place, Pangong Lake via Shyok route. We take a left from DURBUK. After crossing Tangtse, you will see the first view of world famous Pangong TSO. Spend the night at lake side camps. This gives us an additional opportunity to ride/drive as real off roading and experience water crossing. This also saves a day for us and we get a chance to ride along the SHYOK RIVER.

DAY 09 After spending an unforgettable night on the bank of Pangong TSO, post breakfast we head towards Leh. Enroute we will cross the Changla Pass (3rd highest motorable pass), have a quick break at Karu for refreshment. Visit Shey monastery, Thikshey monastery and Rancho School. Reach Leh by early evening and check in at the hotel. Overnight stay in your hotel at Leh

DAY 10 After breakfast, check out and head towards Sarchu. On the route of Leh- Manali highway, you will experience bumpy ride to the mighty Tanglang La, another high pass, in the land of high passes, taking you through the "highway to hell". Roads here are tricky, demanding high alertness, cautioning the bikers at every turn. Overnight stay at camp in green mesmersing nature.





DAY 11

Today get ready to finish up the tough & bumpy ride, and reach Manali. We ride through the Atal tunnel or Rohtang, to reach the lower altitudes. We reach Manali and get refreshed in our own way. Say thanks to mighty Himalaya for your good & safe journey and enjoy overnight in Manali.

DAY 12

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From Manali, after having breakfast, we start towards the last leg of our Leh Ladakh Tour Package. We take the route via, Kullu, Mandi, Kiratpur and Ambala to reach Delhi by evening. Conclude the tour concludes and take with you lots of unforgettable memories.
