

Your dream tour to Leh Ladakh kicks off by boarding Volvo bus from Delhi in the evening and reaching Manali in the morning. Check into your hotel and take rest. You have the rest of the day at leisure with you. You can go around shopping on the Mall Road or visit some famous points in Manali. Late evening, we would also be handing you the bikes for the upcoming adventure.

Day 2: Manali to Sarchu, 165 kms

The second day of Leh Ladakh tour highlights crossing the Atal Tunnel. After having a healthy breakfast, we hit the road for Sarchu, crossing the valley of Lahaul Spiti. You will enjoy mesmerizing scenic beauty along with Chandara and Bhaga river. This highway route, takes you into the heart of the mountains. Enjoy the splendid view as you pass through the Baralach La Pass. Keep riding towards Sarchu which is the border line between Kashmir and Ladakh. Relax for the rest of day and keep a high intake on fluids to keep away AMS (acute mountain sickness). Stay overnight in camp in Sarchu.

Day 3: Sarchu to Leh, 260 kms

After an early breakfast, we leave for the last leg of our onward journey towards Leh, crossing Gata Loops, the 21 hair pin bends, giving you the chance to ride on all types of road i.e tarmac, stony, quick and unbelievable U turns. You will actually get to know as to why this road is often called by many as the "Highway to Hell". We pass through Skyangchu Thang (a vast plateau stretching for 42 kms) and then cross Tanglang-La (17,585ft) to reach Leh by evening. Check in to your hotel and relax overnite in Leh.

Day 4: Leh to Nubra Valley, 150 kms

Gear up and speed off on the smooth tarmac to meet the board showing "The Highest Motorable Road in the world" at Khardung La Pass. After taking a break for photo session on this high pass to the Nubra Valley, we head towards Khardung village where you can have a quick break for tea and snacks. We proceed towards Nubra Valley as we cross the Khalsar and Diskit sectors. Visit Diskit monastery, indulge in ATV rides at the Sand Dunes and ride on the double humper Bactarian camels before retiring into your camps at Nubra.



Day 5: Nubra to Pangong, 170 kms

From Nubra Valley, we journey to another captivating destination, Pangong Lake via the Shyok route. We make a left turn at Durbuk, and after passing Tangtse, the stunning first glimpse of the world-renowned Pangong Tso awaits. We will spend the night at lakeside camps, providing us with an exciting opportunity for true off-roading and water crossings. This route also allows us to save a day, letting us ride alongside the beautiful Shyok River. We will spend the night at the Pangong camp.

Day 6: Pangong to Hanle, 250 kms

On this day of the tour, you get to explore the road leading to the highest observatory of the world. Enroute Hanle, you will visit Rezang La war memorial at Chushul, as you go from Pangong towards Nyoma. You can also enjoy star gazing under the roof of milky way galaxy at Hanle. The high altitude, clear skies, and minimal light pollution make it an ideal location for astronomical observations. The observatory hosts a range of telescopes, including the Himalayan Chandra Telescope, enabling scientists to study and explore the vast expanse of the universe. Night stay at Hanle.

Day 7: Day trip to Umling La Pass, 220 kms

Get ready for some high-altitude, heart-pumping adventure. Get set to ride the world's highest motorable road via the unbeaten path of Nurbu La! As you cruise away from Hanle village, the trail leads you through a mysterious no-man's valley, with multiple routes to explore. You'll feel the rush as the fine sand of the valley flies under your wheels. Once you reach the well-paved road at Nurbu La top, soak in the stunning scenery as you ride along the Kingdul River. Unlike typical high mountain passes, you won't see any scary valleys here. And when you finally hit the peak and your bike starts to lose steam, snap a victorious pic at the top of the world! Night stay at Hanle.



Day 8: Hanle to Leh, 270 kms

Friends, gear up for the last hurrah of our epic ride through the Changthang region! Today, we're headed to the ultimate destination of the barren lands and crossing the mighty Indus River at Loma. Take a breather at the Loma checkpoint, because from here on out, it's a wild ride on a 2-lane highway, cruising alongside the Indus River. Before you know it, we'll be pulling up to the lunch spot at Chumathang, where nature's boiling hot springs will blow your mind! And just like that, we'll be rolling into our hotel in Leh, ready to kick back and relax after one heck of a journey.

Day 9: Leh to Kargil, 220 kms

The journey from Leh to Kargil is akin to traveling down a runway and marks the initial leg of the day's adventure. As you transition from the predominantly Buddhist Leh to the Islamic-majority Kargil, embrace the symbolic change. Along the way, we will visit the Hall of Fame, offer prayers at Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, marvel at Magnetic Hill, and witness the confluence at Sangam, all while heading towards the highest monastery in Ladakh, Lamayuru Monastery. We will cross the Fotu La before settling in Kargil for the night.

Day 10: Kargil to Srinagar, 220 kms

Start your journey by riding through Drass, the second coldest inhabited place on the planet, and take a moment to visit the Drass War Museum to honor and pray for the brave souls of the valiant soldiers who fought and sacrificed their lives during the Kargil War of 1999. Continue your ride to cross Zoji La and descend into Sonmarg, leaving behind the arid, dry, and vegetation-less yet stunning landscapes of Ladakh. You will be welcomed by the lush greenery of Sonmarg, one of the most breathtaking regions in "Heaven on Earth - Kashmir." Once you reach Srinagar, enjoy a shikara ride on Dal Lake, explore the Mughal Gardens, visit the Shankaracharya Temple, and discover other tourist attractions. Spend the night in Srinagar.



Day 11: Depart from Srinagar

After having breakfast, we conclude the Leh Ladakh tour here, as we drop you at the airport, and you take with you lots of unforgettable memories to your onward journey.
